MOVER MONEY:

The Florida Department of Transportation is set to close a funding gap for a planned up-to-\$342-plus million mover linking Miami International Airport with the now-under-construction Miami Intermodal Center, future home of a consolidated rental car facility. County commissioners learned last year that the project faced a \$30 million deficit that Miami-Dade Aviation couldn't fill. The state department is to pitch in another \$34 million toward the project, bringing the department's contribution to more than \$100.5 million. The additional state funding comes from "reprogrammed" existing aviation project funds, county documents say, and is to be disbursed over three years beginning in fiscal 2010. A groundbreaking for the mover project is set for 11 a.m. March 2.
