

**PARSONS-ODEBRECHT GETS
CONTRACT FOR \$259 MILLION
MIA PEOPLE-MOVER**

Parsons has announced that the Parsons-Odebrecht Joint Venture has been awarded a contract by the Miami-Dade County Board of Commissioners to build a 1.27-mile Automated People Mover system to run between Miami International Airport and the Miami Intermodal Center, an off-airport multimodal transportation center that includes transfers to regional rail, bus, and rental car services. This \$259 million contract includes the full turnkey design, engineering, system construction, and delivery of eight state-of-the-art Crystal Mover APM vehicles.

"The POJV team successfully completed the new South Terminal expansion program last year, and we look forward to continuing to serve the Miami-Dade Aviation Department on this new contract as well as the contract for the North Terminal," stated Jim Shappell, Parsons Group President. "This project will help relieve airport congestion, benefiting MIA travelers and the entire South Florida region."

The MIA APM system will use cutting-edge Crystal Mover vehicle technology, which is in successful operation or in deployment at several major airports. A veteran in aviation services, Parsons is currently working on numerous large airport programs worldwide, including the United States, Asia, the Middle East, and Europe.

When complete, the MIA APM system will have two station stops and will connect the airport terminal with the MIC.
