## How to Rent a Transport Vehicle at Miami Airport

This article is for people who are visiting Miami and will need a rental vehicle and want to drive it themselves around the city that could be small car, big car, van, whatever, depending upon their specific requirements, have an easily available option of renting it at Miami International Airport. If the traveler is keen on renting a vehicle represented at MIA, let me tell you that there are 16 such companies available in that category.

If you are okay with hiring any airport transport rental company as long as they are dependable and professional then, you do not have to wait to arrive at Miami Airport to do it. Book one from their own town/city/ state/country on phone, over mail or if its too urgent via cell phone text messaging service. Make sure your briefings are accurate.

The entire vehicle represented at MIA is housed in the MIA Car Center (RCC), located just a mile away from the airport.

Reaching the Rental Car Center is not really difficult. A shuttle bus service takes travelers from the Miami International Airport arrival gate to the Rental Car Center (RCC) lobby, where these travelers can identify a particular rental car company for themselves.

Once you get your baggage, step outside the terminal by following the “Ground Transportation” signs placed everywhere for the convenience of travelers and wait for the white bus that reads “Rental Car Shuttle.” If you are a first time traveler to Miami or are unsure of where to catch the shuttle, go ahead and ask a transportation attendant who is always ready to help.

Now let's shed some light on the last aspect of renting a car, which is returning the car. When the traveler wants to return the rental car, he should go to the MIA Rental Car Center at 3900 N.W. 25th Street. Make sure that you have the latest and proper directions as old maps and GPS navigation systems may still have the old address for the rental company that may cause unnecessary delay and waste of time and fuel. Once you reach the center, there are signs that point you to the right section for your rental car company.

Do all the formalities required and leave! Easy, isn't it? As long as you know how to go about it, nothing is difficult.
