MIA Tri-Rail Station to Close Monday

The airport's Tri-Rail Station will close for two years

Starting Monday, the Tri-Rail station at Miami International Airport will close for two years due to construction of the Miami Intermodal Center.

Closing the station will reduce the MIC's build time by about 21 months, saving \$10 million in taxpayer construction costs, according to a release from the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority.

During the construction period, the station will be rebuilt and connected to the airport via an escalator and people mover.

Once the airport station closes, southbound rail service will end at the Hialeah Market Station. From there, buses will take riders to and from the airport. Travelers should expect no more than 10 minutes added to their travel time to the airport.

Trailers have been installed at the Hialeah station to house a ticket agent and bathrooms. More lighting has been added, as well as 60 parking spaces and 24-hour security.

Two northbound trains, P638 and P642, will originate from the Metrorail Transfer Station and two southbound trains, P631 and P635, will terminate at the Metrorail Transfer Station. Passengers will be bused to and from the Hialeah Market Station and the Airport for these trains.
