Metrorail to connect to MIA in July

Miami Dade Transit has announced that the Miami International Airport Metrorail station will open for rail service on July 28.

The station at 3800 N.W. 25th St. is located at the Miami Intermodal Center, which is adjacent to the airport and includes the MIA Mover, rental car center, and future transportation hub Miami Central Station. Passengers will be able to take the Metrorail's Orange Line, which will run from the Dadeland South station to MIA, to the airport station and then travel on the 1.25-mile elevated MIA Mover to access the airport terminal.

On July 22, seven Metrobus routes currently serving the MIA terminal will be realigned to serve the new airport Metrorail station. The routes are the 7, 37, 42, 57, J, 150 Airport Flyer and 238 East-West Connection.

In addition, Metrorail service will double in frequency between the Dadeland South station and Earlington Heights station.
