FULL CLOSURE OF SR-953 / LEJEUNE ROAD (NW 42ND AVENUE) and CENTRAL BOULEVARD (NW 21ST STREET), INCLUDING NB ON-RAMP FOR MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ON MAY 8, 2006

Miami-Dade County – Monday, May 8th, 2006 from 2:00 A.M. to 3:00 A.M.: SR-953/LeJeune Road, Central Boulevard (NW 21st Street), Northbound LeJeune Road On-Ramp for Miami International Airport and Eastbound On-Ramp to NW 21st Street will be **completely closed for two rolling stops for a period of approximately 20 minutes each during the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 3:00 A.M.** MIA Police Officers will be on site to assist with traffic. This closure is required for safety reasons during the removal of the flag pole at NW 21st Street in preparation for the bridge reconstruction work being performed by Kiewit Southern Co. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation. This work is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. Miami-Dade County – On Monday, May 8th, 2006 between 2:00 A.M. and 3:00 A.M. for two periods of approximately 20 minutes. **Northbound and southbound LeJeune Road at NW 21st Street will be closed. Eastbound and westbound lanes of the NW 21st Street bridge (Central Boulevard) will also be closed for the same period of time including the Entrance Ramp to Miami International Airport from northbound LeJeune Road and the Entrance Ramp to eastbound NW 21st Street (Central Boulevard) from southbound LeJeune Road.** MIA Police Officers will be on-site to assist traffic during this period.

This work is being done to remove the flagpole on NW 21st Street in preparation for the bridge reconstruction. Kiewit Southern Co. (formerly known as Gilbert Southern Corp.) will be performing the work for the Florida Department of Transportation.
