CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Temporary Closure of NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court:

Commencing Monday, February 2, 2004 at 7:00 a.m. through Wednesday, February 4, 2004 at 7:00 a.m.: NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court will be temporarily closed. Westbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Court. Eastbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Court up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road). All other traffic to follow posted detour signs. Temporary closure is due to milling, resurfacing and paving activities. Work will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. Variable Message Signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) Project: Construction of an Additional Westbound Lane From SR-112 to Okeechobee Road Off-ramp

DATES: February 2 to February 9, 2004

MAINLINE: As part of the improvements to SR-112, there will be intermittent lane closures, one at a time, on westbound SR-112 between NW 32nd Avenue and Okeechobee Road from **Monday, February 2 to Saturday, February 7, 2004**. These closures will be during the non-peak hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Also, westbound on SR-112 at the NW 37th Avenue bridge, up to two lanes will be closed from **Monday, February 2 to Saturday, February 7, 2004**. One lane will be closed from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. and the second lane will be closed from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Additionally, on westbound SR-112, at the NW 37th Place Bridge, one lane will be closed from **Tuesday, February 3 to Thursday, February 5, 2004**, between the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Motorists should look out for roadway detours.
