CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Temporary Full Road Closure of the Intersection at NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 14th Street and Temporary Ramp Closure for Westbound SR-836 Off-Ramp at NW 37th Avenue

Commencing Friday, February 20, 2004 at 7:30 p.m. until Saturday, February 21, 2004 at 7:00 a.m., the intersection at NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 14th Street will be temporarily closed. This temporary closure will be necessary for the installation of a pipeline for the new pump station. Local businesses and residential access will be maintained on the affected roadways. Southbound through traffic on NW 37th Avenue should turn left at NW 14th Terrace, turn right at NW 34th Avenue, go straight until NW 11th Street and turn right to go back onto NW 37th Avenue. Northbound through traffic on NW 37th Avenue should turn right at NW 11th Street, turn left at NW 34th Avenue, go straight until NW 14th Terrace and turn left to go back onto NW 37th Avenue. In conjunction with this road closure, the westbound SR-836 exit ramp on NW 37th Avenue will be temporarily closed. Motorist on Westbound SR-836 should keep right and use the next exit on NW 42nd Avenue (Le Jeune Road). **Crew working hours will be from 9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.** This activity will be performed by Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department. An off-duty police officer will be on site and Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place advising commuters of detours and intersection closures. Only Emergency Vehicles will be provided access through this closure.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Intermittent Lane Closure along NW 25th Street from NW 39th Avenue to NW 37th Avenue

Commencing, Tuesday, February 17, 2004 through Friday, February 27, 2004: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center, there will be intermittent lane closures along NW 25th Street from NW 39th Avenue to NW 37th Avenue. This work is due the installation and removal of electrical poles. Work is being performed by Florida Power & Light Company.

Construction Activity No. 3:

Temporary Closure of NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court:

Commencing Friday 20, 2004 at 7:00 a.m. through Friday, February 27, 2004 at 7:00 a.m.: NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court will be temporarily closed. Westbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Court. Eastbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Court up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road). All other traffic to follow posted detour signs. Temporary closure is due to milling, resurfacing and paving activities. Work will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. Variable Message Signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
