CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Nighttime Lane Closures on State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) at the Intersections of NW 25th Street and NW 26th Street:

Commencing Thursday, February 26, 2004 at 9:00 p.m. through Friday, February 27, 2004 at 5:00 a.m.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, there will be intermittent lane closures on SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) at the intersections of NW 25 Street and NW 26 Street during non-peak hours from 9:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. These lane closures are due to the restoration of pavement conditions at these intersections. The work will be performed by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc (Mastec North America). This work will be performed during weeknights in order to lessen the impact on the traveling motorists.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Paving Operations at Tri-Rail's Southwest Parking Lot located on NW 21st Street and NW 39th Avenue

Commencing Friday, February 27, 2004: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, there will be paving operations at the Tri-Rail's southwest parking lot. Work is being performed by Turner Construction (Central Florida Utilities)

Construction Activity No. 3:

Temporary Lane Closures on NW 21st Street from NW 37th Avenue to NW 39th Avenue

Commencing on Saturday, February 28, 2004 to Sunday, February 29, 2004: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center, the left westbound and left eastbound lanes, including the center turning lanes along NW 21st Street from NW 37th Avenue to NW 39th Avenue, will be temporarily closed. At least one lane in each direction will be maintained open to traffic. This closure is due the restoration of the pavement conditions. Crew working hours will be during **non-peak hours from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** Work is being performed by Turner Construction (Central Florida Utilities).

Construction Activity No. 4:

Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) Project: Construction of an Additional Westbound Lane From SR-112 to Okeechobee Road Off-ramp

DATES: March 1, 2004 to March 8, 2004

MAINLINE: As part of the improvements to SR-112, there will be intermittent lane closures, one at a time, on westbound SR-112 between NW 32nd Avenue and Okeechobee Road from **Monday, March 1 to Saturday, March 6, 2004**. These closures will be during the non-peak hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Also, westbound on SR-112 at the NW 37th Avenue bridge, up to two lanes will be closed from **Monday, March 1 to Saturday, March 6, 2004**. One lane will be closed from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. and the second lane will be closed from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Additionally, on westbound SR-112, at the NW 37th Place Bridge, one lane will be closed from **Tuesday, March 2 to Thursday, March 4, 2004**, between the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Motorists should look out for roadway detours.
