CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) Project: Construction of an Additional Westbound Lane From SR-112 to Okeechobee Road Off-ramp

DATES: March 29 to April 5, 2004

MAINLINE: As part of the improvements to SR-112, the Okeechobee exit ramp will be closed from Monday, March 29 to Thursday, April 1, 2004 from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Roadway signs will be posted indicating detour at NW 36 Street. There will be intermittent lane closures, one at a time, on westbound SR-112 between NW 32nd Avenue and Okeechobee Road from **Monday, March 29 to Saturday, April 3, 2004**. These closures will be during the non-peak hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Also, westbound on SR-112 at the NW 37th Avenue bridge, one lane will be closed from **Monday, March 29 to Saturday, April 3, 2004 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** In addition, up to two westbound lanes will be closed during the night from **Monday, March 29 to Saturday, April 3, 2004**. One lane will be closed from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. and the second lane will be closed from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. On westbound SR-112, at the NW 37th Place Bridge, one lane will be closed from **Monday, March 29 to Saturday, April 3, 2004**, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. For more information on this project call Bridget Appow at (305) 860-3740 or contact MDX at info@mdx-way.com
