CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Nighttime Lane Closures on SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) from South of NW 21st Street to NW 27th Street

Commencing Tuesday, April 13, 2004 through Friday, April 30, 2004: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, two northbound inside lanes on **LeJeune Road from south of NW 21st Street to NW 27th Street will be closed weeknights, from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.** These lane closures are due the installation of a new 6" gas line by City Gas Company of Florida (Mueller Distribution). **This work will be performed during weeknights in order to lessen the impact on the traveling motorists.** Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place to detour traffic.

Construction Activity No. 2:

NW 25th Street from West of NW 39th Avenue to SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road)

Commencing Wednesday, April 21, 2004 through Wednesday, May 19, 2004: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, the westbound lane on NW 25th Street from west of NW 39th Avenue to SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) will be temporarily closed. Westbound and Eastbound traffic on NW 25th Street will be shifted onto the eastbound lanes. A pedestrian detour will be in place to direct pedestrians around the work zone. Access to local business will be maintained at all times. **Crew working hours will be from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** These lane closures are due utility work being performed by WRS Infrastructure & Environment, Inc.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
