CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Nighttime Lane Closures on SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) from NW 25th Street to NW 31st Street

Commencing Tuesday, July 6, 2004 through Friday, July 9, 2004: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, up to three northbound right lanes on NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) from NW 25th Street to NW 31st Street will be closed weeknights from 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. These lane closures are due the installation of fire hydrants on the east side of LeJeune Road. **This work will be performed during weeknights in order to lessen the impact on the traveling motorists.** Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place to divert traffic. Work is being performed by Turner Construction (Solo Construction).

Construction Activity No. 2:

NW 25th Street from SR-953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road)

Commencing Tuesday, July 6, 2004 through Monday, November 1, 2004: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, the eastbound lane on NW 25th Street from NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) will be closed from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Two-way traffic will be maintained using flag persons to divert traffic around the work zone. Commuters should follow construction signs. The lane closure is due the installation of a new electrical duct bank for the Miami Intermodal Center Rental Car Facility. Work is being performed by Florida Power and Light Company (Mega Tran).

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
