*****DUE TO HURRICANE IVAN – THIS CLOSURE HAS BEEN RESCHEDULED FROM MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2004 TO MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 20, 2004 AS FOLLOWS:*****

Temporary Ramp Closure of Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp on Eastbound Central Boulevard (NW 21st Street):

Commencing Monday, September 20, 2004 through Thursday, September 23, 2004: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, the Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp on Eastbound Central Boulevard (NW 21st Street) to Eastbound SR 112, SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) North and Southbound will be temporarily closed. **Closure and Crew working hours will be from 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM - Monday through Thursday Nights Only.** This temporary closure is necessary for the installation of a sheet pile wall in preparation for construction of a future bridge connection to the MIC. A maintenance of traffic plan will be in place to detour vehicular traffic as follows:

Maintenance of Traffic (Detour): All traffic will be re-routed through Central Boulevard (NW 21st Street). **Eastbound SR-112 and Northbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue)** traffic will turn left on NW 37th Avenue, turn left on NW 25th Street, continue to LeJeune Road and make a right on LeJeune Road to continue north.

Southbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) traffic will turn right on NW 37th Avenue and continue until NW 14th Street where it will turn left onto LeJeune Road going south. **Westbound SR-836 and Southbound LeJeune Road** traffic will turn right on NW 14th Street, continue to LeJeune Road and turn left. **Eastbound SR-836** traffic will continue on NW 37th Avenue and make a left onto the SR-836 Eastbound On-ramp. This activity will be performed by EBSARY Foundation for Turner Construction. Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place advising commuters of detour.

Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
