### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

#### *Construction Activity No. 1:*

##### NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street between LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) and NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue:

**Commencing Monday, September 27, 2004 through Friday, October 1, 2004:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program's MTAR Roadways, NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street between LeJeune Road and NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be reduced to one lane during nighttime hours only from 8:00 PM to 5:00 AM. This lane reduction is necessary to install cross drains associated with improvements to NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street. Eastbound and Westbound traffic will be diverted around the construction area under the direction of flagmen. This work is being performed by Central Florida Equipment on behalf of Turner Construction.

#### *Construction Activity No. 2:*

##### Temporary Closure of Service Road adjacent to Wyndham Miami Airport Hotel located on NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street:

**Commencing Monday, September 27, 2004 through Friday, December 10, 2004:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, the service road located adjacent to the Wyndham Miami Airport Hotel along the East Side Parking Lot will be temporary closed throughout the construction. This closure is due to the installation of a 20" force main and the construction of the foundations for the future Automatic People Mover (APM) connection from the Miami International Airport to the MIC's Rental Car Facility/Central Station.

**Maintenance of Traffic:** This service road will be closed to all vehicular and pedestrian traffic. During the closure, all existing parking along the service road will be removed. Only Authorized vehicles needing to utilize the service road will be permitted access through the hotel parking lot. The Wyndham Miami Airport Hotel entrance will be limited to a two-way access only. This work is being performed by Solo Construction on behalf of Turner Construction.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
