## **CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITES UPDATE**

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE LEFT TURN LANE INTO BUILDING 5A - MIAMI DADE AVIATION DEPARTMENT AT THE INTERSECTION OF NW 31<sup>ST</sup> STREET AND NORTHBOUND LEJEUNE ROAD:

Commencing Monday, October 4, 2004 through Friday, November 5, 2004: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program, the left turn lane into Building 5A of the Miami Dade Aviation Department at the intersection of NW 31<sup>st</sup> Street and Northbound LeJeune Road will be temporary closed. Building 5A traffic will follow the posted detour and Electronic Message Signs as shown on the attached detour plan. This closure is due to the installation of the 16" watermain which is part of the infrastructure preparation for LeJeune Road and service connection to the Rental Car Facility. Utility work will be performed by Solo Construction (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
