CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Temporary Westbound Lane Closure on NW 14 Street from NW 42 Avenue to NW 45th Court:

Commencing Monday, November 1, 2004 through Tuesday, November 30, 2004: The westbound lane on NW 14th Street will be temporarily closed between LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) to NW 45th Court. **The intersection of NW 14th Street and NW 42nd Court will be closed weeknights from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. from Monday, November 1, 2004 through Friday, November 5, 2004. Maintenance of Traffic (Detour):** Westbound thru traffic on NW 14th Street should turn left at NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road), turn right at NW 12th Street Drive to NW 45th Avenue, North on NW 45th Avenue; NW 42nd Court will be open from NW 12th Street Drive for NW 42nd Court north/southbound traffic only. Variable Message Signs (VMS) signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures. This utility work is being done by Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Temporary Lane Closures on SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) at NW 18th Street

Commencing Tuesday, November 2, 2004 through Thursday, November 4, 2004: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program's LeJeune CD Southbound Project, one inside lane northbound and southbound on LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) at NW 18th Street will be temporarily closed from **9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** Crews will be performing median curb and pavement restoration work. This work will be performed by APAC construction on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 3:

Temporary Road Closure on NW 14 Street, between NW 42 Avenue (LeJeune Road) and NW 42 Court:

Monday, November 8, 2004 from 9:00 PM to 5:30 AM: NW 14th Street from LeJeune Road to NW 42nd Court will be temporarily closed. This closure is due to the pouring of the bridge deck portion of the LeJeune Road CD South project which is part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program. Detours will be in place to re-route west and eastbound traffic as follows: **Maintenance of Traffic (Detour):** Westbound thru traffic on NW 14th Street should turn left at NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road), turn right at NW 12th Street and turn right onto NW 42nd Court and go back to NW 14th Street. **Eastbound** thru traffic on NW 14th Street should turn right on NW 42nd Court, turn right on NW 12th Street Drive, go straight until NW 45th Avenue and turn left. Continue on NW 45th Avenue until NW 7th Street, turn left on NW 7th Street and go east, turn left at NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) and go north to NW 14th Street. Variable Message Signs (VMS) signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures. This closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. This work is being done by APAC Construction on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
