CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Temporary Nighttime Closure on NW 43rd Place from NW 14th Street to NW 13th Street:

Commencing Wednesday, January 19, 2005 through Wednesday, January 26, 2005: NW 43rd Place from NW 14th Street to NW 13th Street will be temporary closed weeknights from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. **Maintenance of Traffic (Detour):** Westbound thru traffic on NW 14th Street should turn left at NW 42nd Court, turn right at NW 12th Street, drive to NW 45th Avenue and go North/South on NW 45th Avenue; Eastbound thru traffic on NW 13th Street should stay on NW 45th Avenue, following the detour to NW 7th Street, turn left to go on LeJeune Road north. **Airport Employees: NW 14th Street from NW 42nd Court to NW 43rd Place (Airport Parking Entrance/Exit) will be open to Airport Employees Only.** Airport Employees exiting through NW 43rd Place will need to travel east on NW 14th Street to LeJeune Road. A police officer will be on site. This utility work is being done by Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Lane Closures on State Road 953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) at NW 18th Street:

(Change from originally scheduled closure of January 18, 2005 through January 20th, 2005)

Commencing Tuesday, January 25, 2005 through Thursday, January 27, 2005: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program's LeJeune Road CD Southbound Project, **one northbound lane and one southbound lane on LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) at NW 18th Street will be closed nightly from 9:00 PM to 5:30 AM.** Crews will be removing the pole foundations. This work is being performed by APAC Construction (Mastec) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
