### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

#### *Construction Activity No. 1:*

#### **Temporary Nighttime Closure of NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street between the North and Southbound Airport Ramps to LeJeune Road and NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue:**

**On Friday morning (February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2005), at about 12:01 A.M. to 1:00 A.M.:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR Project, both East and Westbound traffic on NW 21 Street between the north and southbound airport ramps to LeJeune Road and NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be completely closed. All through traffic should use NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue as a detour to avoid the area. The contractor will be moving heavy equipment across the street during this time. Police Officers will be present to detour traffic.

#### *Construction Activity No. 2:*

#### **Temporary Closure of Eastbound and Westbound Traffic on NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street at LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue):**

**Commencing Saturday, February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2005 at 7:00 a.m. through Monday, February 28, 2005 at 5:30 a.m.:** As part of the MIC's LeJeune Road Corridor Projects - Package 2, NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street at LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed. Eastbound and Westbound traffic on NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street will not be permitted to cross LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue). Motorists will need to follow the posted detour:

#### **Maintenance of Traffic Detour:**

**Eastbound traffic** on NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street, west of LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue), needing to continue east on 11<sup>th</sup> Street or north onto LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) will be directed south on LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) to NW 9<sup>th</sup> Street where U-Turns will be permitted.

**Westbound traffic** on NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street, east of LeJeune Road (NW 42 Avenue), will be detoured south on NW 41 Avenue to NW 7<sup>th</sup> Street, then west to LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue). Motorists wishing to access NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street and areas west of LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) will continue west on NW 7<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, then north on NW 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue to NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Lane Reduction:** In addition, during this closure, Southbound LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) may be reduced to one lane at NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street from **Saturday, February 26, 2005 at 11:00 p.m. through Monday, February 28, 2005 at 5:30 a.m.** Flagmen and Police Officers will guide traffic (including the SR-836 Eastbound/Westbound Off-Ramp traffic to Southbound LeJeune Road) through this intersection.

Crews will be installing a 16" watermain crossing at this intersection. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.
