CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Temporary Nighttime Closure of NW 21st Street between the North and Southbound Airport Ramps to LeJeune Road and NW 37th Avenue:

On Saturday morning (March 5th, 2005), at about 1:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR Project, both East and Westbound traffic on NW 21 Street between the north and southbound airport ramps to LeJeune Road and NW 37th Avenue will be completely closed. All through traffic should use NW 25th Street and NW 37th Avenue as a detour to avoid the area. The contractor will be moving heavy equipment across the street during this time. Police Officers will be present to detour traffic. This work is being done by Case Atlantic (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure of the Eastbound Lane on NW 21st Street Off-Ramp to Northbound LeJeune Road and State Road 112:

Commencing Tuesday, March 8, 2005 through Wednesday, March 9, 2005: As part of the MIC's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2: One eastbound lane on NW 21st Street off-ramp to Northbound LeJeune Road and State Road 112 will be closed, **weeknights only, from 9:00 PM to 5:30 AM.** Crews will be performing general roadwork. This work is being done by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
