Maintenance of Traffic Bulletin #174 **March 7, 2005**

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Temporary Nighttime Closure of NW 21st Street between the North and Southbound Airport Ramps to LeJeune Road and NW 37th Avenue:

On Tuesday morning (March 8th, 2005), at about 1:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR Project, both East and Westbound traffic on NW 21 Street between the north and southbound airport ramps to LeJeune Road and NW 37th Avenue will be completely closed. All through traffic should use NW 25th Street and NW 37th Avenue as a detour to avoid the area. The contractor will be moving heavy equipment across the street during this time. Police Officers will be present to detour traffic. This work is being done by Case Atlantic (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Temporary Westbound Lane Closures on NW 25th Street from NW 38th Court to NW 39th Avenue:

Commencing Monday, March 7, 2005 through Thursday, March 10, 2005: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR Project, **the westbound lane on NW 25th Street from NW 38th Court to NW 39th Avenue will be temporarily closed throughout construction. (Detour): Westbound traffic** on NW 25th Street will need to turn right on NW 38th Court, turn left on NW 39th Avenue, and turn right on NW 25th Street to continue to reach their destination. **Eastbound traffic** on NW 25th Street will be shifted onto the westbound lane and will continue through on NW 25th Street. Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. This closure is required for the installation of a drainage system at this location and is being performed by Central Florida Equipment Rentals (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 3:

Temporary Closure of Eastbound and Westbound Traffic on NW 11th Street at LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue):

Commencing Saturday, March 12th, 2005 at 7:00 a.m. through Monday, March 14th, 2005 at 5:30 a.m.: As part of the MIC's LeJeune Road Corridor Projects - Package 2, **NW 11th Street at LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed. Eastbound and Westbound traffic on NW 11th Street will not be permitted to cross LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue).** Motorists will need to follow the posted detour:

Maintenance of Traffic Detour:

Eastbound traffic on NW 11th Street, west of LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue), needing to continue east on 11th Street or north onto LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) will be directed south on LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) to NW 9th Street where U-Turns will be permitted.

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Westbound traffic on NW 11th Street, east of LeJeune Road (NW 42 Avenue), will be detoured south on NW 41 Avenue to NW 7th Street, then west to LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue). Motorists wishing to access NW 11th Street and areas west of LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) will continue west on NW 7th Street to NW 43rd Avenue, then north on NW 43rd Avenue to NW 11th Street.

Lane Reduction: In addition, during this closure, Southbound LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) may be reduced to one lane at NW 11th Street from **Saturday, March 12th, 2005 at 11:00 p.m. through Monday, March 14th, 2005 at 5:30 a.m.** Flagmen and Police Officers will guide traffic (including the SR-836 Eastbound/Westbound Off-Ramp traffic to Southbound LeJeune Road) through this intersection.

Crews will be installing a 16" watermain crossing at this intersection. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
