### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

#### *Construction Activity No. 1:*

#### **Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Northbound LeJeune Road/Northbound SR-112:**

**On Wednesday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:30 A.M.:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, **One Lane on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) MIA's Exit Ramp onto Northbound LeJeune Road and Northbound SR-112 will be temporary closed.** Crews will be performing emergency repairs of the lighting system on this ramp. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### *Construction Activity No. 2:*

#### **Temporary Nighttime Closure of Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road:**

**(Note: Due to unforeseen conditions, this closure will NOT occur tonight, Wednesday, March 23, 2005 but will continue on Thursday, March 24, 2005)**

**Commencing Monday, March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2005 through Thursday, March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Nightly:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, **Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) MIA's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road will be temporary closed during nighttime hours only from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Detour:** Motorists will need to follow the posted detour and exit onto Northbound LeJeune Road, turn right at NW 26<sup>th</sup> Street and continue to NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue and make a right until NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street, and continue to LeJeune Road to go **Southbound.** Crews will be performing roadwork on this ramp. Closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impact to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
