### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

#### *Construction Activity No. 1*

##### NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street from NW 38<sup>th</sup> Court to NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue:

**Commencing Monday, April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2005 through Monday April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2005:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR Project, **east and westbound traffic on NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street will be shifted to temporary pavement between NW 38<sup>th</sup> Court and NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue.** This work will also require closure of NW 38<sup>th</sup> Court at NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street. Local business traffic should use NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue to access NW 38<sup>th</sup> Court. This closure is required for the installation of a drainage system at this location and is being performed by Central Florida Equipment Rentals (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### *Construction Activity No. 2:*

##### Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Northbound LeJeune Road/Northbound SR-112:

**Continuing from Monday, April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2005 through Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:30 A.M. (Excluding Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays):** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, **One Lane on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) MIA's Exit Ramp onto Northbound LeJeune Road and Northbound SR-112 will be temporarily closed.** Crews will be performing general roadway and paving operations. This closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### *Construction Activity No. 3:*

##### Temporary Nighttime Closure of Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road:

**Continuing from Thursday, April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2005 through Thursday, April 28, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Nightly (Excluding Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays):** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, **Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) MIA's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed nightly.**

**Southbound LeJeune Detour: Motorists will need to follow the posted detour on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) through Airport Exit No. 1 to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue, turn right and continue south until NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street, turn right and continue to LeJeune Road and turn left to continue in the Southbound direction.** Crews will be performing roadwork on this ramp. Closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impact to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

**Construction Activity No. 4:**

**Lane Closure on Northbound LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) from approximately NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street:**

**Continuing from Monday, April 18, 2005 through Thursday, May 5, 2005 (Weekdays Only):** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, **the Outside Lane on Northbound LeJeune Road from approximately NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street will be temporarily closed daily from 5:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. Two lanes will remain open to traffic.** Crews will be performing general road work. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. (WRS) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
