CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1

Lane Closure on Eastbound/Westbound SR-836 Exit Ramps onto Northbound LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue):

Saturday, April 23, 2005 from 6:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, **traffic exiting from Eastbound/Westbound SR-836 Exit Ramps onto Northbound LeJeune Road will be merged onto one lane.** Crews will be removing and relocating trees in the area in preparation for the upcoming roadwork. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. (Vila & Sons) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 2

Lane Closure on Northbound LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) from approximately NW 18th Street to just South of NW 25th Street:

Continuing through Friday, May 20th, 2005 (Weekdays Only): As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, **the Outside Lane on Northbound LeJeune Road from approximately NW 18th Street to just south of NW 25th Street will be temporarily closed, weekdays only, from 5:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.** Two lanes will remain open to traffic. **The Entrance Ramp to Miami International Airport will also remain open.** Crews will be performing general road work. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. (WRS) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 3:

Temporary Lane Closures on LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) from NW 9th Street to NW 14th Street:

Continuing through Friday, June 10, 2005: As part of the MIC's LeJeune Road Corridor Projects - Package 2, **one northbound and one southbound inside lane on LeJeune Road from NW 9th Street to NW 14th Street will continue to be closed throughout construction.** **Southbound motorists wishing to enter the Marriott Miami Airport Hotel complex are advised to continue south on LeJeune Road and make a U-turn at NW 9th Street.** Crews are completing the installation of the 16" watermain along this section. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
