### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

#### *Construction Activity No. 1:*

##### **Lane Shifts on Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Northbound LeJeune Road and Northbound SR-112:**

**Effective Monday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2005 at 9:00 P.M.:** As part of the MIC's Terminal Access Roadway (MTAR) Project, **traffic exiting Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Northbound LeJeune Road and Northbound SR-112 will be shifted to temporary pavement on the connector ramp between NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street and LeJeune Road.** This shift is being done in order to start construction of the new connector bridge which will take travelers from the future Rental Car Facility to Northbound LeJeune Road.

#### *Construction Activity No. 2:*

##### **Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure on Southbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) from NW 31<sup>st</sup> Street to approximately 150' North:**

**Commencing Monday, April 25, 2005 through Tuesday, May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2005:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program's LeJeune Watermain Project, **one lane on Southbound LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) from NW 31<sup>st</sup> Street to approximately 150' North will be temporarily closed during nighttime hours only from 9:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M.** Crews will be completing the installation of the 16" watermain at this location. This closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. This work is being done by Solo Construction (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### *Construction Activity No. 3:*

##### **NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue from NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 26<sup>th</sup> Street:**

**Commencing Monday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2005 at 7:00 A.M. through Monday, May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2005 at 5:00 P.M.:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR Project, NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue from NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 26<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed to through traffic. **Local business traffic should use NW 38<sup>th</sup> Court and NW 26<sup>th</sup> Street to access NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue. In addition, east and westbound traffic on NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street will be shifted to temporary pavement between NW 38<sup>th</sup> Court and NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue.** This closure is required for the installation of a drainage system at this location. This work is being performed by Central Florida Equipment Rentals (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### *Construction Activity No. 4:*

##### **Lane Closure on Eastbound/Westbound SR-836 Exit Ramps onto Northbound LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue):**

**Saturday, April 30, 2005 from 6:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, **traffic exiting from Eastbound/Westbound SR-836 Exit Ramps onto Northbound LeJeune Road will be merged onto one lane.** Crews will be removing and relocating trees in the area in preparation for the upcoming roadwork. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. (Vila & Sons) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
