CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

NW 21 Street at NW 39th Avenue:

Commencing Monday, May 2, 2005 at 7:00 A.M. to Monday, May 9, 2005 at 4:00 P.M.: As part of the MIC's Terminal Access Roadway (MTAR) Project, one eastbound lane and one westbound lane on **NW 21 Street at NW 39 Avenue will be closed continuously**. Traffic will be shifted to one lane in each direction on the south side of the roadway. Crews will be performing general roadwork. Work will be performed by Case Atlantic (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Temporary Nighttime Closure of Eastbound NW 21st Street (Central Boulevard) Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road:

Continuing from Monday, May 2, 2005 to Thursday, May 26, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Nightly (Excluding Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays): As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, **Eastbound NW 21st Street (Central Boulevard) MIA's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed nightly**.

Southbound LeJeune Detour: Motorists will need to follow the posted detour on **Eastbound NW 21st Street (Central Boulevard) through Airport Exit No. 1 to NW 37th Avenue, turn right and continue south until NW 14th Street, turn right and continue to LeJeune Road and turn left to continue in the Southbound direction**. Crews will be performing roadwork on this ramp. Closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impact to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 3:

(THIS ACTIVITY HAS BEEN TEMPORARILY CANCELLED AND WILL BE RESCHEDULED)

NW 39th Avenue from NW 25th Street to NW 26th Street:

Commencing Monday, April 25th, 2005 at 7:00 A.M. through Monday, May 8th, 2005 at 5:00 P.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR Project, NW 39th Avenue from NW 25th Street to NW 26th Street will be closed to through traffic. **Local business traffic should use NW 38th Court and NW 26th Street to access NW 39th Avenue. In addition, east and westbound traffic on NW 25th Street will be shifted to temporary pavement between NW 38th Court and NW 39th Avenue**. This closure is required for the installation of a drainage system at this location. This work is being performed by Central Florida Equipment Rentals (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
