### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

#### *Construction Activity No. 1:*

#### **Temporary Nighttime Closure of Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road:**

**Continuing from Tuesday, May 31, 2005 until Thursday, June 30, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Nightly (Excluding Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays):** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) MIA's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed.

**Southbound LeJeune Detour:** Motorists will need to follow the posted detour on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) through Airport Exit No. 1 to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue, turn right and continue south until NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street, turn right and continue to LeJeune Road and turn left to continue in the Southbound direction. Crews will be performing roadwork on this ramp. Closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impact to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### *Construction Activity No. 2:*

#### **Temporary Lane Closures on LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) from NW 9<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street:**

**Continuing through Thursday, June 30, 2005:** As part of the MIC's LeJeune Road Corridor Projects - Package 2, one northbound and one southbound inside lane on LeJeune Road from NW 9<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street will continue to be closed throughout construction. Crews are completing the installation of the 16" watermain along this section. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### *Construction Activity No. 3*

#### **Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure on Southbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) from NW 31<sup>st</sup> Street to approximately 150' North:**

**Commencing Monday, June 20, 2005 through Saturday, June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2005:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program's LeJeune Watermain Project, one lane on Southbound LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) from NW 31<sup>st</sup> Street to approximately 150' North will be temporarily closed during nighttime hours only from 9:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Crews will be completing the installation of the 16" watermain at this location. This closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. This work is being done by Solo Construction (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

**Construction Activity No. 4:**

**Temporary Nighttime Lane Closures on Northbound LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) from NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street and from NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street to NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street:**

**Commencing Friday, June 24, 2005 through Tuesday, June 28, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:30 A.M. (Nightly):** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, **two northbound lanes on LeJeune Road from NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street and from NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street to NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street will be temporarily closed during nighttime hours** while the contractor relocates the concrete barrier wall for the installation of the 16" watermain from NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street to NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street. One northbound lane will be open to traffic. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
