CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Temporary Nighttime Lane Closures on Northbound and Southbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) from NW 11th Street to NW 14th Street:

Commencing Monday, August 8, 2005 at 10:00 P.M. through Thursday, August 19, 2005 at 5:30 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, the northbound and southbound outside lanes on LeJeune Road from NW 11th Street to NW 14th Street will be temporarily closed. Access to Marriott Miami Airport Hotel complex will be maintained. This closure is required in order to protect the machinery used during the installation of the roadway lighting system in this area. Work will be performed by Mastec (Gilbert Southern Corp.) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 2:

<u>Temporary Nighttime Closure of Eastbound NW 21st Street (Central Boulevard) Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road:</u>

Continuing from Monday, August 12, 2005 until Thursday, August 31, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Nightly (Excluding Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays): As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, Eastbound NW 21st Street (Central Boulevard) MIA's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed.

Southbound LeJeune Detour: Motorists will need to follow the posted detour on Eastbound NW 21st Street (Central Boulevard) through Airport Exit No. 1 to NW 37th Avenue, turn right and continue south until NW 14th Street, turn right and continue to LeJeune Road and turn left to continue in the Southbound direction. Crews will be performing roadwork on this ramp. Closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impact to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
