CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Truck and Bus Detour on Northbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) and NW 25th Street:

Commencing Friday, August 12, 2005 at 7:00 A.M. through Tuesday, September 6, 2005 at 7:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR Project, the right turn lane on SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) to Eastbound NW 25th Street will be restricted to vehicle traffic only. All truck and bus traffic will need to follow the posted detour signs on Northbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue), turn right on NW 26th Street and turn right on NW 39th Avenue to continue to NW 25th Street. This restriction will be in place throughout construction and is required to complete the roadwork on the south side of NW 25th Street. Work will be performed by Central Florida Equipment (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure at the of Intersection of NW 25th Street and LeJeune Road: On

Friday August 12, 2005 from 9:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M.: as part of the Miami Intermodal Center MTAR Project, the left turn lane on westbound NW 25th Street to southbound LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed. Motorist will need to go on NW 37th Avenue, turn right on NW 14th Street and turn left on LeJeune Road to continue south. This closure is required in order to install a utility valve at this intersection. The work is being performed by Solo Construction (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
