### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

**(DUE TO THE HEAVY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES ALONG LEJEUNE ROAD, DRIVERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO SEEK ALTERNATE ROUTES TO AVOID ANTICIPATED TRAFFIC DELAYS.)**

#### *Construction Activity No. 1:*

**Temporary Nighttime Closure of Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road:**

**Continuing from Monday, August 12, 2005 until Thursday, September 8, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Nightly (Excluding Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays):** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) MIA's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed.

**Southbound LeJeune Detour:** Motorists will need to follow the posted detour on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) through Airport Exit No. 1 to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue, turn right and continue south until NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street, turn right and continue to LeJeune Road and turn left to continue in the Southbound direction. Crews will be performing roadwork on this ramp. Closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impact to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### *Construction Activity No. 2:*

**Temporary Nighttime Lane Closures on Northbound and Southbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) from NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street:**

**Commencing Monday, August 22, 2005 at 10:00 P.M. through Thursday, August 25, 2005 at 5:30 A.M. (Nightly):** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, the northbound and southbound outside lanes on LeJeune Road from NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street will be temporarily closed. Access to SR-836 and Marriott Miami Airport Hotel complex will be maintained. This closure is required in order to protect the machinery used during the installation of the roadway lighting system in this area. Work will be performed by Mastec (Gilbert Southern Corp.) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### *Construction Activity No. 3:*

**NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street from East of the Railroad Tracks at NW 38<sup>th</sup> Court to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue:**

**Commencing on Monday, August 22, 2005 at 7:00 A.M. through Friday, October 21, 2005 at 5:00 P.M.:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR Project, eastbound and westbound traffic on NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street from East of the Railroad Tracks at NW 38<sup>th</sup> Court to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be shifted onto new temporary pavement. This traffic shift is required to construct the south side of the new NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street. Work will be performed by Central Florida Equipment (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

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#### **Construction Activity No. 4:**

#### **Temporary Nighttime Closure of Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Northbound LeJeune Road:**

**Commencing Tuesday, August 23, 2005 at 10:00 P.M. until Wednesday, August 24, 2005 at 4:00 A.M.:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR Project, **Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) MIA's Exit Ramp onto Northbound LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed.**

**Northbound LeJeune Detour:** Motorists will need to follow the posted detour on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) through Airport Exit No. 1 to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue, turn left and continue north until NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street, turn left and continue to LeJeune Road and turn right to continue in the Northbound direction. Crews will be performing bridgework on this ramp. Closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impact to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Turner Construction on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### **Construction Activity No. 5:**

#### **Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure on Southbound LeJeune Road from NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street:**

**Commencing Monday, August 29, 2005 at 11:00 P.M. to Monday, September 12, 2005 at 5:00 A.M. (Nightly):** As part of the LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project – Package 2, **one lane will be temporarily closed from NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street. Entrance to Miami International Airport and NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street On-Ramp will remain open at all times.** Crews will be installing the waterline in this area. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corporation on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### **Construction Activity No. 6:**

#### **Temporary Nighttime Closure at the of Intersection of NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street and LeJeune Road:**

**Commencing Monday, September 5, 2005 at 9:30 P.M. through Friday, September 16, 2005 at 5:00 A.M. (Nightly):** As part of the LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project – Package 2, **the left turn lane on westbound NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street to southbound LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed. Detour:** Motorist will need to follow the posted detour to go south on NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue, turn right on NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street and turn left on LeJeune Road to continue south. **In addition, the left turn lane on Southbound LeJeune Road at NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street will also be temporarily closed. Detour:** Motorist wishing to turn left on NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street will need to follow the posted detour and turn left on NW 27<sup>th</sup> Street, turn right on NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue and turn left on NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street to continue in the eastbound direction. This closure is required in order to tie into the new watermain system as this intersection. The work is being performed by Gilbert Southern Corporation on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
