CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

(DUE TO THE HEAVY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES ALONG LEJEUNE ROAD, DRIVERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO SEEK ALTERNATE ROUTES TO AVOID ANTICIPATED TRAFFIC DELAYS)

Construction Activity No. 1:

Temporary Nighttime Lane Closures on Northbound and Southbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) from NW 11th Street to NW 14th Street:

Continuing through Friday, September 30, 2005: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, the northbound and southbound outside lanes on LeJeune Road from NW 11th Street to NW 14th Street will continue to be temporarily closed nightly from 10:00 P.M. to 5:30 A.M. Access to SR-836 and Marriott Miami Airport Hotel complex will be maintained. This closure is required in order to protect the machinery used during the installation of the roadway lighting system in this area. Work will be performed by Mastec (Gilbert Southern Corp.) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure on Southbound LeJeune Road from NW 25th Street to NW 21st Street:

Continuing through Monday, September 26, 2005: As part of the LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project – Package 2, one lane from NW 25th Street to NW 21st Street will continue to be temporarily closed nightly from 11:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Entrance to Miami International Airport and NW 21st Street On-Ramp will remain open at all times. Crews will be installing the waterline in this area. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corporation on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 3:

Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure on Northbound LeJeune Road at NW 25th Street:

Commencing Thursday, September 8, 2005 at 10:00 P.M. through Friday, September 9, 2005 at 5:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR Project, the outside lane on northbound LeJeune Road at NW 25th Street will be temporarily closed. Crews will be preparing the curb area for the upcoming reconstruction of NW 25th Street. The work is being performed by Central Florida Equipment (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
