CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Partial Closure of Intersection at NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 25th Street:

Commencing Thursday, September 8, 2005 through Friday, September 9, 2005 from 9:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Nightly: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's MTAR project, the southwest corner of the intersection at NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 25th Street will be temporarily closed. Flagmen will be directing traffic around the work zone. Crews will be installing two drainage structures in this area. Work will be performed by Central Florida Utilities (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Temporary Nighttime Closures on Northbound LeJeune Road from NW 25th Street to NW 31st Street:

Commencing Sunday, September 11, 2005 at 9:00 P.M. through Monday, September 12, 2005 at 5:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program's LeJeune Watermain Project, the northbound lane from NW 25th Street to NW 31st Street will be temporarily closed. Crews will be performing pavement restoration along northbound LeJeune Road and at the intersection of NW 31st Street. Work will be performed by Solo Construction (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Construction Activity No. 3:

Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure on Southbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) from NW 31st Street to approximately 150' North:

Monday, September 12, 2005: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program's LeJeune Watermain Project, **one lane on Southbound LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) from NW 31st Street to approximately 150' North will be temporarily closed during nighttime hours only from 9:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M.** Construction crews will be completing utility work on the new 16" watermain. This closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. This work is being done by Solo Construction (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
