### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

**(DUE TO THE HEAVY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES ALONG LEJEUNE ROAD, DRIVERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO SEEK ALTERNATE ROUTES TO AVOID ANTICIPATED TRAFFIC DELAYS.)**

#### *Construction Activity No. 1:*

#### **Temporary Nighttime Closure of Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road:**

**Monday, September 26, 2005 and Tuesday, September 27, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Nightly:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, **Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) MIA's Exit Ramp onto Southbound LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M.**

**Southbound LeJeune Road Detour:** Motorists will need to follow the posted detour on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) through Airport Exit No. 1 to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue, turn right and continue south until NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street, turn right and continue to LeJeune Road and turn left to continue in the Southbound direction. Crews will be performing roadwork on this ramp. Closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impact to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### *Construction Activity No. 2:*

#### **Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure on Southbound LeJeune Road from NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street:**

**Commencing Monday, September 26, 2005 through Thursday, September 29, 2005 from 11:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. (Nightly):** As part of the LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project – Package 2, **one lane will be temporarily closed from NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street. Entrance to Miami International Airport and NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street Eastbound On-Ramp will remain open at all times.** Crews will be installing the waterline in this area. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corporation on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### *Construction Activity No. 3:*

#### **Nighttime Right Lane Closure on Southbound LeJeune Road from NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street:**

**Thursday, September 29, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M.:** As part of the LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project – Package 2, **the right lane on Southbound LeJeune Road from NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street will be temporarily closed.** Crews will be installing temporary drainage in this section. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
