### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

#### Construction Activity No. 1:

##### Full Closure of Southbound Lanes on LeJeune Road at NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street:

**Tuesday, October 11, 2005 and Wednesday, October 12, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Nightly:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project – Package 2, the Southbound lanes on LeJeune Road at NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street will be completely closed nightly from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. **Detour: All traffic wishing to continue on Southbound LeJeune Road and/or use the On-Ramp to Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street will need to follow the posted detour route and turn left on NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street, travel east on NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road) and turn right. Continue on NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue until NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street, turn right and continue until LeJeune Road and turn left to continue in the Southbound direction.** This closure is required in order to install the watermain at this location. This work is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts on the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### Construction Activity No. 2:

##### Partial Closure of Intersection at NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street and LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue)

**Continuing through Tuesday, October 18, 2005:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project – Package 2, the intersection at NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street and LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) will be temporarily closed nightly from **10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M.** One lane in each direction will remain open at all times. This closure is required in order to pave and restore the roadway at this location. This work is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts on the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### Construction Activity No. 3:

##### Temporary Nighttime Lane Closure on Southbound LeJeune Road from NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street:

**Continuing through Thursday, October 13, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. (Nightly):** As part of the LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project – Package 2, **one additional lane will be temporarily closed from NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street. One lane will remain open at all times.** Crews will be installing the temporary drainage system in this area. This work is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corporation on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
