### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

#### Construction Activity No. 1:

##### Full Closure of Southbound Lanes on LeJeune Road at NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street:

**Monday, October 17, 2005 and Tuesday, October 18, 2005 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Nightly:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project – Package 2, the Southbound lanes on LeJeune Road at NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street will be completely closed nightly from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. **Detour:** All traffic wishing to continue on Southbound LeJeune Road and/or use the On-Ramp to Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street will need to follow the posted detour route and turn left on NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street, travel east on NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road) and turn right. Continue on NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue until NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street, turn right and continue until LeJeune Road and turn left to continue in the southbound direction. This closure is required in order to install the watermain at this location. This work is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts on the traveling public. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### Construction Activity No. 2:

##### Temporary Closure of NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street at LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue):

**Saturday, October 15, 2005 from 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. and Saturday, October 22, 2005 from 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.:** As part of the MIC's LeJeune Road Corridor Projects - Package 2, NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street at LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed. Traffic on NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street will not be permitted to cross LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue). Motorists will need to follow the posted detour:

#### Maintenance of Traffic Detour:

**Eastbound traffic** on NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street, west of LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue), needing to continue east on 11<sup>th</sup> Street or north onto LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) will be directed south on LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) to NW 9<sup>th</sup> Street where U-Turns will be permitted.

**Westbound traffic** on NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street, east of LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue), will be detoured south on NW 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue to NW 7<sup>th</sup> Street, then west to LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue). Motorists wishing to access NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street and areas west of LeJeune Road (NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) will continue west on NW 7<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, then north on NW 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue to NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street.

One lane on Northbound and one lane on Southbound LeJeune Road will be maintained open at all times during this closure. This closure is required in order to pave and restore the roadway at this location. Work will be performed by Gilbert Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
