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### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #1:

#### **Temporary Lane Closure of Southbound LeJeune Road (SR-953/NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) at NW 21st Street:**

**Tuesday, February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2006 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:30 A.M.:** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project, Package 2, **one southbound lane at a time on LeJeune Road at NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street will be closed. One lane will remain open at all times.** This closure is required to verify existing utilities. Work is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts on the traveling public. This Work will be performed by Florida City Gas for the Florida Department of Transportation.

#### **Cierre Temporal de Carrilera de LeJeune Road(Carretera Estatal 953/Avenida 42 del NW), Rumbo Sur y la Calle 21 del NW:**

**El martes 7 de febrero, 2006 desde las 10:00 P.M. hasta las 5:30 A.M.:** Como parte de la Segunda Porción del Proyecto de Reconstrucción de LeJeune Road del Centro Intermodal de Miami, **habrá cierre de una carrilera (una a la vez) en LeJeune Road, rumbo sur, y la Calle 21 del NW. La otra carrilera se mantendrá abierta en todo momento.** Este cierre es necesario para verificar los servicios públicos existentes. El trabajo será llevado a cabo por la noche para aminorar el impacto al público motorizado. El trabajo será efectuado por Florida City Gas para el Departamento de Transporte de la Florida.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
