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CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #1:

Lane Closures and Traffic Shift on Central Boulevard (NW 21st Street) just west of NW 39th Avenue:

Commencing Friday, August 4, 2006 from 8:00 P.M. to Saturday, August 5, 2006 at 8:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, intermittent lane closures will be in place while crews complete the temporary pavement in this area. Once pavement is complete, **traffic traveling eastbound and westbound on Central Boulevard (NW 21st Street) just west of NW 39th Avenue will be shifted north onto new temporary pavement.** This new traffic pattern will be in place while crews continue with the bridge reconstruction of the south side of NW 21st Street. This closure and traffic shift is being done during nighttime hours in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. This work is being done by Kiewit Southern Co. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Cierres y Cambios a Nuevas Carrileras en Central Boulevard (Calle 21 del NW) al oeste de la Avenida 39 del NW:

Comenzando a las 8:00 P.M. del viernes 4 de agosto del 2006 hasta las 8:00 A.M. del sábado 5 de agosto del 2006: Como parte de la Segunda Porción del Proyecto de Reconstrucción de LeJeune Road habrán cierres intermitentes de carrileras mientras que los trabajadores completan el pavimento nuevo temporal en esta área. Una vez terminado, **se implementará el cambio del tránsito rumbo este y oeste en Central Boulevard (Calle 21 del NW) justo al oeste de la Avenida 39 del NW, hacia la nueva carretera temporal recién construida del lado norte.** Este nuevo patrón de tráfico se mantendrá en efecto mientras que se este llevando a cabo la reconstrucción del puente del lado sur de la Calle 21 del NW. El cambio tomará efecto de noche para aminorar el impacto al público motorizado. El trabajo lo llevará a cabo Kiewit Southern Co. Para el Departamento de Transporte de la Florida.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #2:

Traffic Shift on Eastbound NW 21st Street (Central Boulevard) Miami International Airport's Exit Ramp #3 onto Northbound LeJeune Road:

Commencing Friday, August 4, 2006 from 8:00 P.M. to Saturday, August 5, 2006 at 8:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Projects – Package 2, once crews complete the paving operations, traffic traveling on **Eastbound NW 21st Street (Central Boulevard) MIA's Exit Ramp #3 onto Northbound LeJeune Road will shifted onto the newly constructed exit ramp.** This shift is being done during nighttime hours in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. This work is being done by Kiewit Southern Co. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Cambio de Tránsito a nuevas carrileras en la Calle 21 del NW (Central Boulevard), Rumbo Este, Rampa de Salida del Aeropuerto Internacional de Miami #3 hacia LeJeune Road, Rumbo Norte:

Comenzando a las 8:00 P.M. del viernes 4 de agosto del 2006 hasta las 8:00 A.M. del sábado 5 de agosto del 2006: Como parte de la Segunda Porción del Proyecto de Reconstrucción de LeJeune Road, una vez que se complete el proceso de la pavimentación, **el tráfico rumbo este de la Calle 21 del NW (Central Boulevard), rampa de salida del Aeropuerto Internacional de Miami #3 hacia LeJeune Road rumbo norte se moverá hacia la nueva rampa recién construida.** El cambio tomará efecto de noche para aminorar el impacto al público motorizado. El trabajo lo llevará a cabo Kiewit Southern Co. Para el Departamento de Transporte de la Florida.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes.
