CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #1:

Temporary Closure of NW 28th Street at SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue):

Saturday, December 2, 2006 from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.: As part of the LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project, NW 28th Street at LeJeune Road will be temporarily closed between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. while crews conduct pre-trenching operations for verification of underground utilities. **BUSINESS ACCESS DETOUR:** Commuters traveling northbound and southbound LeJeune Road wishing to access businesses on NW 28th Street will need to follow the posted detour and turn on NW 25th Street, continue east until NW 39th Avenue, turn left and continue to NW 28th Street and turn left to access businesses. This work is being done by Kiewit Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Cierre Temporal de la Calle 28 del NW, a la altura de la Carretera Estatal 953/LeJeune Road (Avenida 42 del NW):

El sábado 2 de diciembre de 2006 entre las 7:00 a.m. hasta la 5:00 p.m.: Como parte de la Segunda Porción del Proyecto de la Reconstrucción de LeJeune Road, los equipos de trabajo estarán inspeccionando las líneas soterradas de servicios públicos y cerrarán la Calle 28 del NW a la altura de LeJeune Road. **DESVIO PARA ACCESO A LOS NEGOCIOS:** Los viajantes de LeJeune Road rumbo norte y sur que deseen acceso a los negocios de la Calle 28 del NW deberán de seguir las instrucciones de los carteles de desvío y doblar por la Calle 25 del NW, continuar hacia el este hasta la Avenida 39 del NW, doblar a la izquierda hasta la Calle 28 del NW donde doblarán a la izquierda para tener acceso a los negocios. Este trabajo lo esta llevando a cabo Kiewit Southern Corp. para el Departamento de Transporte de la Florida.

Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
