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**CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #1:**

**Intersection at NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street:**

**Commencing Thursday, December 13, 2007 through Friday, December 14, 2007 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (Daily):** As part of the LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project, **the right turn lanes on Northbound and Southbound NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road) and Westbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street** will be temporarily closed while crews install the new taxi light system at this intersection. Lane closures will not be done at the same time. Work will be performed by Kiewit on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

**Intersección de la Avenida 37 del NW (Douglas Road) y la Calle 21 del NW:**

**Comenzando el jueves, 13 de diciembre del 2007 hasta el viernes, 14 de diciembre del 2007 desde las 9:00 a.m. hasta las 5:00 p.m. (Diario):** Como parte del proyecto de construcción de LeJeune Road, **la carrilera de doblar derecha en la Avenida 37 de NW (Douglas Road), rumbos norte y sur, y en la Calle 21 del NW, rumbo oeste,** serán temporalmente cerrada mientras que los obreros instalan un sistema de luces para los taxistas en esta intersección. Los cierres de las carrileras no se van hacer juntos. El trabajo lo llevará a cabo Kiewit Southern Corp. para el Departamento de Transporte de la Florida.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
