

**TRAFFIC ADVISORY BULLETIN # 353**

**May 1, 2008**

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**CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #1:**

**Full Ramp Closure of Miami International Airport's (MIA) Exit Ramps #2, #3 & #4 onto SR-112/Northbound LeJeune Road/Southbound LeJeune Road & Westbound SR-836 from Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard):**

**Thursday, May 1, 2008 and again Saturday, May 3rd through Monday, May 5, 2008 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. (Nightly):** As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Reconstruction Project, MIA's Exit Ramps #2, #3 and #4 will be **completely closed** while crews mounted the new directional signage for the new bridge. **Detour Route: (Northbound)** Motorists will need to follow the posted detour signs on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) through Airport Exit No. 1 to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue, turn left and continue north until NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street, turn left and continue to LeJeune Road and turn right to continue in the Northbound direction. (Southbound) Motorists will need to follow the posted detour signs on Eastbound NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street (Central Boulevard) through Airport Exit No. 1 to NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road), turn right and continue until NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street, turn right and continue to LeJeune Road and turn left to continue in the Southbound direction. Closure is being done at night in order to lessen the impact to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Kiewit Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

**Cierre Completo de las Rampas #2, #3 y #4 de la Salida del Aeropuerto Internacional de Miami a la Carretera Estatal 112/LeJeune Road Rumbos Norte y Sur y la Carretera Estatal 836 Rumbo Oeste viniendo por la Calle 21 del NW (Central Boulevard), Rumbo Este:**

**Jueves, 1ro de mayo del 2008 y otra vez el sábado, 3 de mayo hasta el lunes, 5 de mayo del 2008 desde las 10:00 P.M. hasta las 5:00 A.M. (Cada Noche):** Como parte del Proyecto de la Reconstrucción de LeJeune Road del Centro Intermodal de Miami, **habrá un cierre completo de las rampas del Aeropuerto Internacional de Miami #2, #3 y #4** mientras los trabajadores instalan los nuevos carteles de dirección en el nuevo puente. **Ruta de Desvío: (Rumbo Norte)** El público motorizado deberá seguir las instrucciones de los carteles de desvío en la **Calle 21 del NW (Central Boulevard)**, rumbo este, por la **Salida No. 1 del Aeropuerto Internacional de Miami** hacia la **Avenida 37 del NW**, doblar a la izquierda y continuar norte hasta la **Calle 25 del NW**, doblar a la izquierda hasta llegar a **LeJeune Road** donde doblarán a la derecha para continuar rumbo norte. (Rumbo Sur) El público motorizado deberá seguir las instrucciones de los carteles de desvío en la **Calle 21 del NW (Central Boulevard)**, rumbo este, por la **Salida No. 1 del Aeropuerto Internacional de Miami** hacia la **Avenida 37 del NW (Douglas Road)**, doblar a la derecha y continuar hasta la **Calle 14 del NW**, doblar a la derecha hasta llegar a **LeJeune Road** donde doblarán a la izquierda para continuar rumbo sur. Los cierres serán de noche para aminorar el impacto al público motorizado. El trabajo lo llevará a cabo Kiewit Southern Corp. para el Departamento de Transporte de la Florida.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
