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CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #1:

Full Nighttime Closure of NW 39th Avenue between NW 26th Street and NW 28th Street:

Commencing Tuesday, September 30, 2008 to Friday, October 10, 2008 from 8:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's Roadway Improvement Projects, NW 39th Avenue between NW 26th Street and NW 28th Street will be completely closed while crews install the storm sewer crossings. Commuters should follow posted detour signs. Flagmen will be on site to assist customers to Budget Rent a Car through NW 40th Avenue. This work is being done at night to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. Work will be performed by MCM Engineering & General Contractors on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #2:

Full Closure of Alley between NW 27th Street and NW 28th Street:

Thursday, October 2, 2008 from 7:00 A.M. to Friday, October 3, 2008 at 7:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's Roadway Improvement Projects, the alley between NW 27th Street and NW 28th Street will be completely closed to thru-traffic while crews pour the new concrete valley gutters at each end. Work will be performed by (WRS) MCM Engineering & General Contractors on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #3:

Lane Reduction on Northbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) Exit Ramp just south of NW 21st Street:

Commencing Tuesday, October 7, 2008 to Tuesday, October 14, 2008 from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. (Weekdays Only): As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's LeJeune Road Landscaping Beautification Project, the exit ramp on Northbound LeJeune Road will be reduced to one lane while crews install new trees in the median inside the guardrail. One lane will remain open at all times. Work will be performed by Vila & Sons on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #4:

Full Closure of NW 27th Street from just east of LeJeune Road to approximately 250' East:

Commencing Saturday, October 11, 2008 at 7:00 A.M. to Tuesday, October 14, 2008 at 8:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's Roadway Improvement Projects, NW 27th Street from just east of LeJeune Road to approximately 250' East will be completely closed while crews pave the new roadway. Access to Businesses will be maintained through NW 39th Avenue. Commuters should follow posted detour signs. Work will be performed by MCM Engineering & General Contractors on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #5:

Full Closure of NW 28th Street from just east of LeJeune Road to approximately 250' East:

Commencing Saturday, October 11, 2008 at 7:00 A.M. to Tuesday, October 14, 2008 at 8:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center's Roadway Improvement Projects, NW 28th Street from just east of LeJeune Road to approximately 250' East will be completely closed while crews pave the new roadway. Access to Businesses will be maintained through NW 40th Avenue at NW 29th Street. Commuters should follow posted detour signs. Work will be performed by MCM Engineering & General Contractors on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
