NW 38th Court Closed Permanently From NW 25th Street to NW 22nd Street (North of the Tri-Rail Station Parking Lot Entrance)

Effective immediately: NW 38th Court will be closed permanently from NW 25th Street to NW 22nd Street (North of the Tri-Rail Station Parking Lot Entrance) starting Wednesday, June 4, 2003. The closure will be for remedial activities in association with the development of the Miami Intermodal Center (MIC). The entrances to the Tri-Rail parking lots will not be included in the closed portion of the roadway and will remain accessible to the public.

The remedial activities will include clearing and preparing the work area for construction, relocating the Rinker fence and the excavation of the buried solid wastes on NW 38th Court. Following the remedial activities, the installation of water and sewer utilities in the same area will take place. The closure of NW 38th Court began June 4th, 2003 and will not reopen. Variable Message Signs have been posted on NW 38th Court advising of closure.
