CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Tri-Rail Parking Lot Spaces along NW 21st Street and NW 39th Avenue: Starting July 12, 2003, two rows of parking spaces of the Tri-Rail Parking Lot on the southwest corner of NW 39th Avenue along NW 21st Street will be temporarily closed for a period of four weeks. The closure will be for remedial activities in association with the development of the Miami Intermodal Center (MIC). The remedial activities will include clearing and preparing the work area for construction and the excavation of the buried solid wastes. Following the remedial activities, the installation of water and sewer utilities in the same area will take place. The entrances to the Tri-Rail parking lots will remain accessible to the public.

Intersection of N.W. 25th Street and NW 39th Avenue: Starting Thursday, July 17, 2003 to Tuesday, July 22, 2003 (weekdays only), the intersection will be partially closed for a period of four days. Traffic will be diverted around the work area. Crews will be working from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Utility work will include cutting and capping the existing 6" gas main adjacent to the westbound side of NW 25th Street at the intersection with NW 39th Avenue. (Work being done by City Gas). VMS Signs will be in place to notify commuters.

Intersection of N.W. 21st Street and NW 39th Avenue: Starting Thursday, July 17, 2003 to Tuesday, July 22, 2003 (weekdays only), the intersection will be partially closed for a period of four days. Traffic will be diverted around the work area. Crews will be working from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Utility work will include cutting and capping the existing 6" gas main on the eastbound side of NW 21st Street at intersection with NW 39th Avenue. VMS Signs will be in place to notify commuters.

As part of the MIC Public Affairs/Comprehensive Community Awareness Program, business interests and area residents affected by this project will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. We thank you for your patience while we improve the roadway for your traveling needs.
