CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

State Road 953 (NW 14th Street) / NW 42nd Court to NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road)

NW 14th Street from NW 42nd Court to NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) is temporarily closed to traffic due to the flooding conditions in the construction area. MDWASA is continuing utility work in this area and are working day and night to alleviate the flooding within the construction zone. **This work should be completed by Monday, August 4, 2003.** Westbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Rd) up to NW 18th Street and out to 42nd Court. Eastbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Court up to 18th Street and out to 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Rd). All other traffic to follow posted detour signs.

State Road 953 (NW 14th Street) / NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road)

Tuesday, August 5, 2003: The westernmost southbound lane and Right Turn Lane on NW 14th Street and 42nd Avenue from about 200 feet north of NW 14th Street to NW 14th Street will be temporarily closed from 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM. Two Southbound lane will remain open. Crews will be installing a 24" water main (utility work by MDWASA). VMS Signs will be in place to notify commuters.

As part of the MIC Public Affairs/Comprehensive Community Awareness Program, business interests and area residents affected by this project will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. We thank you for your patience while we improve the roadway for your traveling needs.
