CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) from NW 13th Street to North of NW 14th Street and Westbound SR-836 Off-Ramp at NW 37th Avenue: Commencing Friday, August 1, 2003 until Monday, October 6, 2003:

The left inside lane of the westbound SR-836 exit ramp on NW 37th Avenue will be temporarily closed. One left turn and one right turn lane will remain open to traffic at all times. **Weekend Work (Saturdays and Sundays):** Two northbound lanes along NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) from NW 13th Street to North of NW 14th Street Intersection will be temporarily closed. Northbound traffic will be shifted to the southbound lanes. One lane in each direction will be open to traffic. The Southbound left turn lane along NW 37th Avenue onto the SR 836 East Ramp will be temporarily closed. Commuters should follow the detour route to NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to go East on SR 836. Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. during weekends only for a period of four (4) weekends. **Weekday Work (Mondays through Fridays):** The inner northbound lane will be restored to keep one lane open for northbound traffic and two lanes open for the southbound traffic. The lane closures are due to drainage and roadway improvements along this intersection. This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. An off-duty police officer will be on site and VMS signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

NW 37th Ave. (Douglas Rd) & NW 21st Street: Commencing Friday, August 8, 2003 until Monday August 11, 2003: The south side of the intersection of NW 37th Avenue and NW 21st Street will be temporarily closed. One lane in each direction will remain open to traffic. Lane closures will be in effect throughout the weekend from Friday at 9:00 p.m. to Monday at 5:30 a.m. This closure is due the installation of a watermain pipe for the MIC Rental Car Facility. Work is being performed by Turner Construction (Central Florida Utilities).

Miami Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) Project: Construction of an Additional Westbound Lane From SR-112 to Okeechobee Road Off-ramp

MAINLINE: As part of the improvements to SR-112, there will be intermittent lane closures, one at a time, on westbound SR 112 between NW 32 Avenue and Okeechobee Road from Monday, August 4 to Saturday, August 9, 2003. These closures will be during non-peak hours from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Also, westbound on SR-112 at the NW 37th Avenue bridge, up to two lanes will be closed from Tuesday, August 5 to Saturday, August 9. One lane will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. and the second lane will be closed from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Additionally, on westbound SR-112 at the NW 37th Place Bridge, one lane will be closed from Tuesday, August 5 to Saturday, August 9 between the hours of 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Motorists should look out for roadway detours. CROSS STREETS: There will be periodical road closures on NW 37th Avenue from NW 36th Street to NW 41st Street during the off-peak hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. from Sunday, August 3 to Saturday, August 9.
