CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

State Road 953 / NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) North of NW 11th Street

Monday, August 4, 2003 and Tuesday, August 5, 2003: The westernmost southbound lane on NW 42nd Avenue across from the Miami Airport Marriott will be temporarily closed from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. One southbound lane will remain open. Crews will be replacing a 12" gate valve (utility work by MDWASA).

State Road 953 / NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) and NW 14th Street

Monday, August 4, 2003 and Tuesday, August 5, 2003: The westernmost southbound lane and Right Turn Lane on NW 14th Street and 42nd Avenue from about 200 feet north of NW 14th Street to NW 14th Street will be temporarily closed from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Two southbound lanes will remain open. Crews will be installing a 24" water main (utility work by MDWASA).

Temporary Change in original Maintenance of Traffic:

NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) from NW 13th Street to North of NW 14th Street and Westbound SR-836 Off-Ramp at NW 37th Avenue: *(This change in Maintenance of Traffic will be in place until Monday, August 11, 2003).*

The two northbound lanes along NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) from NW 13th Street to North of NW 14th Street Intersection will continue to be closed. Northbound traffic will continue on the southbound lane. One lane in each direction will continue open to traffic. The Southbound left turn lane along NW 37th Avenue onto the SR 836 East Ramp will still be closed. Commuters should follow the detour route to NW 42nd Avenue (Le Jeune Road) to go East on SR 836. Pedestrian sidewalk is closed along the eastside of NW 37th avenue, under the SR-836 Bridge. Pedestrian traffic will be diverted around the work area. Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The lane closures are due to drainage and roadway improvements along this intersection. This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. An off-duty police officer will be on site and VMS signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

As part of the MIC Public Affairs/Comprehensive Community Awareness Program, business interests and area residents affected by this project will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. We thank you for your patience while we improve the roadway for your traveling needs.
