Maintenance of Traffic Bulletin #57 August 18, 2003

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) from NW 13th Street to North of NW 14th Street and Westbound SR-836 Off-Ramp at NW 37th Avenue:

Commencing Tuesday, August 19, 2003 until Friday, August 22, 2003: One northbound lane on NW 37th Avenue from NW 13th Street to North of NW 14th Street will be temporarily closed. One northbound lane and two southbound lanes will be open for traffic. In addition, the left inside lane of the westbound SR-836 exit ramp on NW 37th Avenue will be temporarily closed. One left turn and one right turn lane will remain open to traffic at all times. The lane closures are due to drainage and roadway improvements along this intersection. This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. VMS signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

NW 14th Street from NW 42nd Court to State Road 953 / NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road)

Tuesday, August 19, 2003: NW 14th Street from NW 42nd Court to State Road 953 / NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) will be temporarily closed from **7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.** Westbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Rd) up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Court. Eastbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Court up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Rd). All other traffic to follow posted detour signs. Temporary closure is due to the connection of the watermain at this location. Work will be performed by Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Authority (MDWASA). Crew working hours will be from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. VMS Signs will be in place to notify commuters.

NW 14th Street from NW 42nd Court to State Road 953 / NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road)

Commencing Wednesday, August 20th, 2003 through Friday, August 22nd, 2003: The right westbound and right eastbound lanes along NW 14th Street from NW 42nd Court to State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) will be temporarily closed. One eastbound and one westbound lane will be maintained open to traffic. The Pedestrian Sidewalk along this area will also be temporarily closed. Pedestrian traffic will be diverted around the work area. The lane closures are due to drainage improvements and the installation of a new sidewalk, curb and gutter. Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. Variable Message Signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) from NW 13th Street to North of NW 14th Street and Westbound SR-836 Off-Ramp at NW 37th Avenue:

Commencing Friday, August 22, 2003 until Monday, August 25, 2003: The westbound SR-836 exit ramp on NW 37th Avenue will be temporarily closed **from Friday, August 22, 2003 at 9:00 p.m. to Monday, August 25, 2003 at 5:30 a.m.** Motorist on Westbound SR-836 should keep right and use the next exit on NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road). VMS signs will be located on the westbound of SR-836 to detour traffic. In addition, Two northbound lanes along NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) from NW 13th Street to North of NW 14th Street Intersection will be temporarily closed. Northbound traffic will be shifted to the southbound lanes. One lane in each direction will be open to traffic. The Southbound left turn lane along NW 37th Avenue onto the SR 836 East Ramp will be temporarily closed. Commuters should follow the detour route to NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to go East on SR 836. Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. during weekend only. The lane and ramp closures are due to drainage and roadway improvements along this intersection. This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. An off-duty police officer will be on site and VMS signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

NW 14th Street from NW 42nd Court to State Road 953 / NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road)

Commencing Thursday, August 28, 2003 through Friday, August 29, 2003: NW 14th Street from NW 42nd Court to State Road 953 / NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) will be temporarily closed from **7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** Westbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Rd) up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Court. Eastbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Court up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Rd). All other traffic to follow posted detour signs. The temporary closure is due to the milling and resurfacing of the roadway. Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. Variable Message Signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

NW 39th Avenue from NW 21st Street to NW 25th Street:

Commencing Thursday, August 28th, 2003 at 8:00 p.m. to Friday, August 29th, 2003 at 6:00 a.m: Periodic lane closures will occur along NW 39th Avenue from NW 21st Street to NW 25th Street. Flagger will be on site to divert traffic flow around the work zone along NW 39th Avenue. The purpose of these lane closures is for the excavation of test pits for the Miami Intermodal Center. Work will be performed by WRS Infrastructure.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.*
