## Maintenance of Traffic Bulletin #64 **September 2, 2003**

### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

#### NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road) from 50 Feet North of NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 13<sup>th</sup> Street

**Commencing Wednesday, September 3, 2003 through Friday, September 5, 2003:** The right Southbound lane along NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road) from approximately 50 Feet North of NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 13<sup>th</sup> Street will be temporarily closed. One lane will be maintained open. Crews will be working on the restoration of the uneven pavement along this area. **Crew working hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** Work will be performed by MDWASA.

#### NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street from NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Court to State Road 953 / NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue (LeJeune Road)

**Wednesday, September 3, 2003:** Periodic lane closures will occur along westbound lanes of NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street from NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Court to State Road 953 / NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue (LeJeune Road). Flagmen will be on site to divert traffic flow around the work zone on NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street. Crews will be working on patching the potholes along this area. Work will be performed by Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Authority (MDWASA). Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

#### NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue from NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street to NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street:

**Commencing Thursday, September 4, 2003 at 8:00 p.m. until Friday, September 5, 2003 at 6:00 a.m.:** Periodic lane closures will occur along NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue from NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street to NW 25<sup>th</sup> Street. Flagmen will be on site to divert traffic flow around the work zone along NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The purpose of these lane closures is for the excavation of test pits for the Miami Intermodal Center. Work will be performed by WRS Infrastructure.

#### Intersection of NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street:

**Commencing Friday, September 5, 2003 until Monday, September 8, 2003:** The south side of the intersection of NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue and NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street will be temporarily closed. One lane in each direction will remain open to traffic. Lane closures will be in effect throughout the weekend from **Friday, September 5, 2003 at 9:00 p.m. to Monday, September 8, 2003, at 5:30 a.m.** This closure is due the installation of a watermain pipe for the MIC Rental Car Facility. Work is being performed by Turner Construction (Central Florida Equipment).

**Temporary Ramp Closure for Westbound SR-836 Off-Ramp at NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Lane Closure at NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road) from NW 13<sup>th</sup> Street to North of NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street:**

**Commencing Friday, September 5, 2003 until Monday, September 8, 2003:** The westbound SR-836 exit ramp on NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be temporarily closed from **Friday, September 5, 2003 at 8:00 p.m. until Monday, September 8, 2003 at 5:30 a.m.** Motorist on Westbound SR-836 should keep right and use the next exit on NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue (LeJeune Road). VMS signs will be located on the westbound of SR-836 to detour traffic. In addition, Two northbound lanes along NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road) from NW 13<sup>th</sup> Street to North of NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street Intersection will be temporarily closed. Northbound traffic will be shifted to the southbound lanes. One lane in each direction will be open to traffic. The Southbound left turn lane along NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue onto the SR 836 East Ramp will be temporarily closed. Commuters should follow the detour route to NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue (LeJeune Road) to go East on SR 836. **Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** during the weekend only. During weekdays, two southbound lanes and one northbound lane will be open to traffic on NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Douglas Road) from NW 13<sup>th</sup> Street to North of NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street. The lane and ramp closures are due to drainage and roadway improvements along this intersection. This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. An off-duty police officer will be on site and VMS signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures. **This closure will again occur on Friday, September 12, 2003 until Monday, September 15, 2003.**

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.*
