CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Temporary Lane Closures on NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) from approximately 50 feet from the SR-836 Overpass to NW 13th Street

Commencing Monday, September 8, 2003 through Thursday, September 11, 2003: The right Southbound lane along NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) approximately 50 feet from the SR-836 Overpass to NW 13th Street will be temporarily closed. At least one lane in each direction will be open to traffic. Crews will be working on the restoration of the uneven pavement along this area. **Crew working hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** Work will be performed by MDWASA. Off-duty police officers will be on site to direct traffic.

Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) Project: Construction of an Additional Westbound Lane From SR-112 to Okeechobee Road Off-ramp

Commencing Monday, September 8, 2003 to Monday, September 15, 2003: MAINLINE: As part of the improvements to SR-112, there will be intermittent lane closures, one at a time, on westbound SR-112 between NW 32nd Avenue and Okeechobee Road from **Monday, September 8, 2003 to Saturday, September 13, 2003.** These closures will be during the non-peak hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Also, westbound on SR-112 at the NW 37th Avenue bridge, up to two lanes will be closed from Monday, September 8 to Saturday, September 13. One lane will be closed from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. and the second lane will be closed from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Additionally, on westbound SR-112, at the NW 37th Place Bridge, one lane will be closed from **Tuesday, September 9, 2003 to Saturday, September 13** between the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Motorists should look out for roadway detours.
