CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

NW 21st Street from NW 37th Avenue to NW 39th Avenue:

Commencing Monday, September 22, 2003 through Sunday, October 5, 2003: The left westbound and left eastbound lanes including the center turning lanes along NW 21st Street from NW 37th Avenue to approximately 400 feet west of NW 37th Avenue will be temporarily closed. At least one lane in each direction will be maintained open to traffic. Access into and out of the properties located along the north and south sides of NW 21st Street will be restricted to right turns only. All other traffic will be detoured through alternative routes as shown on the attached Detour Map. This closure is due the installation of a watermain pipe for the MIC Rental Car Facility. **Crew working hours will be during non-peak hours from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** Work is being performed by Turner Construction (Central Florida Utilities). Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place advising commuters of lane closures.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Temporary Ramp Closure for Westbound SR-836 Off-Ramp at NW 37th Avenue and Full Lane Closures at NW 14th Street (Frontage Road) from NW 36th Avenue to NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road):

Commencing Friday, September 26, 2003 at 8:00 p.m. until Monday, September 29, 2003 at 5:30 a.m.: The westbound SR-836 exit ramp on NW 37th Avenue will be temporarily closed. Motorist on Westbound SR-836 should keep right and use the next exit on NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road). Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be located on the westbound of SR-836 to detour traffic. In addition, NW 14th Street (Frontage Road) from NW 36th Avenue to NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) Intersection will be temporary closed to thru traffic. Access will be maintained for local traffic only. **Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** during the weekend only.

From Monday, September 29th, 2003 until Friday, October 3, 2003: During weekdays, two southbound lanes and one northbound lane will be open to traffic on NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) from NW 13th Street to North of NW 14th Street. The lane and ramp closures are due to drainage and roadway improvements along this intersection. This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. An off-duty police officer will be on site and VMS signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

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Construction Activity No. 3:

NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court:

Tuesday, September 23, 2003: The right westbound lane along NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court will be temporarily closed. One eastbound and one westbound lane will be maintained open to traffic. The pedestrian sidewalk along this area will also be temporarily closed. Pedestrian traffic will be diverted around the work area.

Wednesday, September 24, 2003: The right eastbound lane along NW 14th Street from NW 42nd Court to State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) will be temporarily closed. One eastbound and one westbound lane will be maintained open to traffic. The pedestrian sidewalk along this area will also be temporarily closed. Pedestrian traffic will be diverted around the work area.

The above lane closures are due to the drainage improvements and removal of curb and gutter along NW 14th Street. **Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place advising commuters.

Construction Activity No. 4:

Temporary Closure of NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court:

Commencing Monday, September 29, 2003 through Friday, October 3, 2003: NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court will be temporarily closed. Westbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Court. Eastbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Court up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road). All other traffic to follow posted detour signs. Temporary closure is due to installation of new sidewalks, curb and gutter, milling, resurfacing and paving activities. Work will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. **Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** Variable Message Signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities.
