CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

Intersection of NW 38th Court and NW 25th Street:

Commencing Tuesday, October 14, 2003 to Wednesday, October 15, 2003: As part of the construction for the Miami Intermodal Center, there will be intermittent lane closures, one at a time, on NW 38th Court, just north of NW 25th Street. These closures will be during non-peak hours from 9:00 p.m. to 3:30 a.m. Flagmen will be on site to divert traffic flow around the work zone. The lane closures are due to the installation of an underground conduit by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (Mastec).

Construction Activity No. 2:

Intersection of NW 39th Avenue and NW 25th Street:

Commencing Wednesday, October 15, 2003 to Thursday, October 16, 2003: As part of the construction for the Miami Intermodal Center, there will be intermittent lane closures, one at a time, on NW 39th Avenue, just north of NW 25th Street. These closures will be during non-peak hours from 9:00 p.m. to 3:30 a.m. Flagmen will be on site to divert traffic flow around the work zone. The lane closures are due to the installation of an underground conduit by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (Mastec).

Construction Activity No. 3:

Temporary Closure of NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court:

Commencing Monday, October 20, 2003 through Friday, October 24, 2003: NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court will be temporarily closed. Westbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Court. Eastbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Court up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road). All other traffic to follow posted detour signs. Temporary closure is due to installation of new sidewalks, curb and gutter, milling, resurfacing and paving activities. Work will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. **Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** Variable Message Signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the Miami Intermodal Center and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
